

Youth Fund Undergoes Annual Performance Evaluation to Enhance Impact

Nairobi, 17 January 2025 - The Youth Fund underwent its annual performance evaluation for the 2023-2024 financial year at its Upperhill offices. The assessment was conducted by the Public Service Performance Management Unit led by Mr. Morris Kamande.

Representing the Youth Fund were Board Chairperson Hon Fatma Barayan, board members Symon Almyda and Josephine Oyombe, along with CEO Josiah Moriasi and the management team.

During the evaluation, Mr. Kamande emphasized the Fund's role in addressing youth unemployment in the country. He noted that the interactive evaluation process would help identify challenges, gaps and areas of improvement.
